Location: in containers, large garden, small garden, ecological zone, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.25 - 0.45 m | **Width:** 0.3 - 0.45 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** neutral (6.6 - 7.5) | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution
