**Location:** park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting

**Height:** 0.75 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 1 - 1 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

#### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.6 - 7.5) | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** spikes, heads, pendulous | **Flower colour:** brown, pale green, green | **Flowering period:** May - July | **Leaf colour:** blue-green, green, dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, grassy | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Twig colour:** green, pale green | **Root system:** shallow, compact
