Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 10 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

Flowers: raceme, panicle, trumpet-shaped, striking, big | **Flower colour:** cream, violet | **Flowering period:** July - August | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, big, wide, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, large, pod, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** brown, green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** coarse roots, fleshy roots, tap root
