Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal | **Height:** 3 - 6 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 10A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: pompom-shaped, striking, half filled | **Flower colour:** pink | **Flowering period:** February - April | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, polished | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown
