TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees | Topiary on stem: multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | Pavement: none | Planting concepts: Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 2.5 - 4.5 m | Width: 2 - 3.5 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, birds | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: papilionaceous, striking, small | Flower colour: pink-violet | Flowering period: April - May | Leaf colour: buds bronze, green | Leaves: deciduous, cordate, thick, Nitrogen fixing | Autumn colour: yellow-orange, orange-red, red-violet | Fruits: striking, pod | Fruit colour: red-brown | Bark colour: grey | Bark: slightly furrowed | Twig colour: brown | Twigs: bare, zigzagging | Root system: deep, extensive
