Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, conifers | **Topiary:** bonsai

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 25 m | **Width:** 12 - 18 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 11B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowering period: November - November | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales | **Fruits:** small, cones | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown
