Location: park, central reservation, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 15 - 25 m | **Width:** 12 - 18 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete | **Flowering period:** September - September | **Leaf colour:** grey-blue | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales | **Fruits:** striking, large, cones | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-black | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** dark grey
