Wind: tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds
