TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: feathered trees, conifers | **Topiary:** hedge

USE

Location: park, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 10 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete, small, big | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** blue-green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, scented | **Fruits:** small, cones | **Fruit colour:** brown, violet | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
