USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral
