USE

Location: park, small garden, patio, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.1 - 0.1 m | **Width:** 0.05 - 0.05 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: spikes, infundibular, striking, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white, pale blue, blue | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** pale green, bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Root system:** shallow, compact, fine roots
