USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B
