USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 2 - 3 m | Width: 2 - 3 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | Soil: sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees | Extreme environments: tolerates air pollution

Flowers: striking, scented, strongly scented | Flower colour: red | Flowering period: March - April | Leaf colour: green | Leaves: deciduous, ovoid | Fruits: edible, small | Fruit colour: grey-green | Twig colour: yellow, green | Twigs: thorned
