TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 10 m | **Width:** 7 - 9 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates heat, curiosity

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, bell-shaped, striking | **Flower colour:** white-pink, pale yellow | **Flowering period:** June - August | **Leaf colour:** matt green, buds bright green | **Leaves:** lanceolate, big, rough, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** with lenticels | **Root system:** shallow
