TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 7 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, star-shaped, striking, singular, scented | **Flower colour:** white, red-violet | **Flowering period:** August - September | **Leaf colour:** buds violet, blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, big, scented with contusion | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, toxic, berry | **Fruit colour:** red-violet, blue-black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare
