TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans

Flowers: catkins, striking | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** February - March | **Leaf colour:** buds yellow, yellow-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, hairy, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** edible, nut | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed, spiral | **Twig colour:** brown, green | **Twigs:** bare
