**Tree types:** standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

**Location:** park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

**Crown shape:** flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 7B

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds
