TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds

Flowers: umbels, striking, scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, polished, undulate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** striking, small, raceme, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown-violet | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, compact, highly branched, many hair roots
