USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown structure: semi-open | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, standing, singular, small | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** striking, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** white, blue | **Bark colour:** coral | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, highly branched, fine roots
