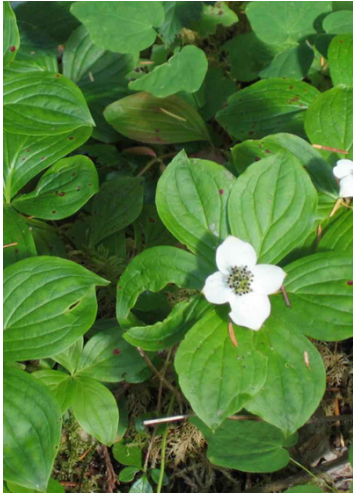


# *Cornus canadensis*

### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover, perennials

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Height:** 0.1 - 0.25 m | **Width:** 0.25 - 0.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 2A - 7B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.0 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, small mammals, birds, humans

**Flowers:** star-shaped | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - July | **Leaf colour:** bright green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, wide | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Fruits:** edible, berry | **Fruit colour:** orange, red | **Bark colour:** pale brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** orange, red, green | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, polished | **Root system:** shallow, many hair roots,
