TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 8 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, striking, standing, scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, big, polished | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** striking, small, raceme, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown-violet | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, many hair roots, fine roots
