TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid, pyramidal | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 4 - 5 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 11A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: heads, star-shaped, striking, singular | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, wide, polished | **Autumn colour:** orange, scarlet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** highly branched, fine roots
