



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | Topiary on stem: multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | Pavement: none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 4 - 6 m | Width: 4 - 6 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral (5.6 - 7.8) | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals | Extreme environments: tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: heads, striking, singular | Flower colour: white, yellow-green | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: dark green, underside white-grey | Leaves: deciduous, ovate, ovoid, opposite, slightly hairy | Autumn colour: scarlet, red-violet | Fruits: small, drupe, raspberry-like | Fruit colour: red | Bark colour: grey-brown | Bark: peeling, furrowed | Twig colour: violet | Twigs: bare, frosty, pendulous | Root system: compact, slightly branched, highly branched, fine roots, central root
