TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 8 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.1 - 7.4) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: heads, star-shaped, striking, big | **Flower colour:** pink-red, pale pink | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds orange-red, dark green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** small, drupe, raspberry-like | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** violet-grey | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** frosty, pendulous | **Root system:** shallow, highly branched, fine roots
