Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, fruit trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 10A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, small mammals, humans
