Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, climate trees | **Topiary on stem:** espalier, pleached

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest

Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 6 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline

Flowers: umbels, striking | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** February - March | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red | **Fruits:** striking, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
