USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden, small garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** urban planting, Eco planting

Height: 0.25 - 0.75 m | **Width:** 1.8 - 2.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: star-shaped, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green, dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** red, green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
