TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 3.5 - 6 m | **Width:** 3 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: star-shaped, flat, striking, standing, singular, big | **Flower colour:** white, cream-white, white-pink, cream, pale pink, pink | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, polished, undulate | **Autumn colour:** scarlet, red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches, finely branched, long shoots | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
