Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, bioswale | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown structure: dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 2A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat, tolerant to short-term flooding
