Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 0

Flowers: raceme, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** February - March | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, orbicular, big | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** discrete | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare
