Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown structure: dense | **Height:** 1.5 - 4 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.6 - 8.2) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat
