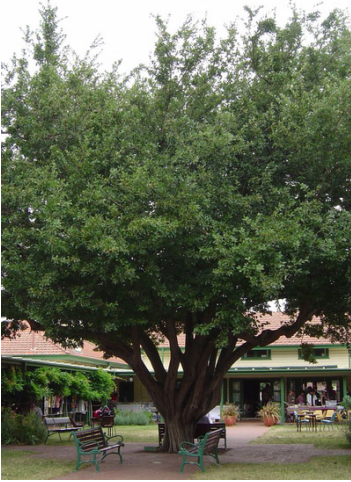




Crataegus x *grignonensis*

TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: street, park, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 6 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, small, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white-pink | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, leathery, polished, lacinate, lobate | **Fruits:** striking, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** thorned
