**Location:** street, avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, ecological zone, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

## ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** raceme | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds red, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, leathery, polished | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, thornless, berry | **Fruit colour:** yellow-orange | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** thorned
