Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, park, central reservation, large garden | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar, narrow oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

Flowers: striking, small | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, lacinate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** thorned
