Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, woodland planting stock, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** pollard, multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** globe, block, bonsai

Location: park, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 7 m | **Width:** 6 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, striking, singular, small, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, leathery, polished, serrate, dentate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** thorned
