**Location:** street, avenue, park, large garden, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

#### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

#### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

**Flowers:** corymbose, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, wide, leathery, polished, lacinate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** striking, edible, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** dark red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** slightly thorned
