USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 8 m | **Width:** 8 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: corymbose, striking, big | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** ovoid, wide, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange | **Fruits:** small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** thorned
