TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** beehive, block, cylinder, pyramid, cone, multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting, shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 8 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: corymbose, striking, half filled, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, leathery, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** orange | **Fruits:** striking, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** thorned
