TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 7 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.5 - 8.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, fire blight resistant

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, striking, standing | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green, buds bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, red | **Fruits:** striking, edible, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** thorned, with lenticels | **Root system:** deep, shallow
