USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.1 - 0.2 m | **Width:** 0.1 - 0.15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, humans

Flowers: tulip-shaped, star-shaped | **Flower colour:** pale violet, violet, pale blue | **Flowering period:** February - March | **Leaf colour:** green, Variegated leaf | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Root system:** compact
