Tree types: feathered trees, conifers

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar, narrow oval | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 10 m | **Width:** 0 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 8A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowering period: January - December | **Leaf colour:** green, dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales | **Fruits:** discrete, cones | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** brown | **Twig colour:** brown
