TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** vase, multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** espalier

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 5 m | **Width:** 5 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.0 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, humans, nectar value 3, pollen value 0 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: striking, singular, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white, white-pink, pink | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, edible, large, aromatic | **Fruit colour:** yellow | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, extensive
