USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, urban planting

Crown structure: dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.9 m | **Width:** 0.8 - 1 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness

Flowers: raceme, striking | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - July | **Leaf colour:** bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate | **Autumn colour:** red | **Fruits:** rarely fruits | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Twig colour:** yellow, red | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, extensive
