Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** beehive, multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** hedge

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, windbreak, coastal area | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

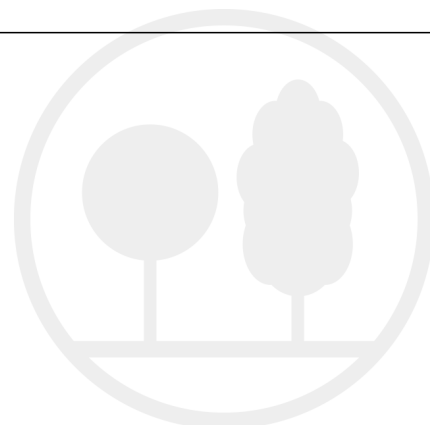
Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: bell-shaped, discrete, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** yellow, silver | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** green, silver | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, lanceolate, Nitrogen fixing | **Fruits:** edible, berry | **Fruit colour:** pale grey | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
