USE

Location: park, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, countryside, coastal area

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide weeping | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 5 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline

Flowers: bell-shaped, discrete, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** yellow, silver | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** silver | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, lanceolate, Nitrogen fixing | **Fruits:** discrete, rarely fruits | **Fruit colour:** grey | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
