Location: park, in containers, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 4, pollen value 4 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
