TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: half-stem trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 11B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** humans

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white, brown | **Flowering period:** October - December | **Leaf colour:** green, underside brown | **Leaves:** evergreen, obovate, lanceolate, big, leathery, underside hairy | **Fruits:** striking, edible, pear | **Fruit colour:** golden yellow | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** pale grey | **Twigs:** hairy
