Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** matt green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, ovoid, dentate | **Autumn colour:** scarlet, dark red, red-violet | **Fruits:** striking, capsule | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** corky | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** corky, horizontal branches, long shoots | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
