Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 10A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline
