TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, feathered trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow weeping | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** dark red, buds red | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, big, polished, slightly hairy, undulate | **Autumn colour:** orange, red-brown | **Fruits:** edible, small, spiny nut | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** green, grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare
